Selected Research Funding Opportunities - For Independent Research or participate in a Penn faculty member's project

- **Penn Undergraduate Research Mentorship Program (PURM)** - \$4,500 for 1st & 2nd year students to participate in Penn faculty member's research project
- **Jumpstart for Juniors** - \$1,000 for student and \$1,000 for faculty mentor to engage 3rd year student on a Penn faculty member's research project
- **College Alumni Society; Vagelos & Class of 1971 Holtz Undergraduate Research Grants** - Up to \$1,000 in research funding to support independent research under the guidance of a Penn faculty member
- **Hassenfeld Foundation Social Impact Research Grant** - 1st, 2nd and 3rd year students in the College who are undertaking innovative research or social entrepreneurship projects with potential for real-world outcomes and significant social impact
- **Penn Undergraduate Climate Action Grants for Sustainability Research** - research in any field related to sustainability (not just climate research)
- **Gelfman International Summer Fund** - funds Juniors from any school to conduct research abroad
- **Mazzatenta Award** - funds Junior and Senior Women in the College for a summer internship or research project
- **College Summer Humanities Internships** - Paid internships at local arts, cultural, and governmental organizations
- **Rose Award, Yardley and Bodek Senior Prizes** - Awards to seniors for outstanding undergraduate research projects

Selected National Fellowships and Scholarships - For Graduate Degrees or Experiential

Rhodes	two or three years of tuition and a living stipend at Oxford University
Marshall	1, 2, or 3 years of graduate tuition and a living stipend at any university in the United Kingdom
Mitchell	one year of graduate tuition and a living stipend at any university in Ireland or Northern Ireland
Gates Cambridge	one, two, or three years of graduate tuition and a living stipend at the University of Cambridge
Churchill	one year of graduate tuition and a living stipend in a STEM field at Churchill College, Cambridge
Soros	\$90,000 toward US graduate school for "new Americans" (immigrants or children of immigrants)
Schwarzman Scholars	one year of graduate tuition and a living stipend at Tsinghua University, Beijing
Yenching Academy	one year of graduate tuition and a living stipend at Peking University, Beijing
Thouron Award	one or two years of graduate tuition and a living stipend at any university in the United Kingdom
Truman (apply as Junior)	up to \$30,000 for juniors planning careers in government, public service, NGO, or advocacy
Beinecke (apply as Junior)	\$34,000 for juniors who received need-based financial aid for grad study in Hum, SocSci, or Arts
President's Engagement Prize	\$150,000 to develop and implement a non-profit local, national, or global engagement project
President's Innovation Prize	\$150,000 to envision and implement a commercial venture that makes a difference in the world
Fulbright	opportunities in over 150 countries for research or study in your field, or teaching English
Projects for Peace	\$10,000 for a summer project anywhere in the name of peace
Boren Fellowship	international language study and research or an internship as part of a graduate degree
Gaither Junior Fellows	post-grad internship in international affairs working with an internationally known fellow
Luce Scholars	professional internships in Asia for those who are not Asia experts
Goldwater (apply as Soph or Jr)	\$7,500 per year for sophomores or juniors planning careers as STEM researchers
Udall (apply as Soph or Jr)	\$7,000 for tuition, fees, books, supplies, or room & board for: <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Students from any background studying the environment, or▪ Native American students studying health care or tribal policy
